Historically, evidence was built around documents as fixed artifacts vs. today, where evidence increasingly consists of events, versions, and individual interactions on documents.

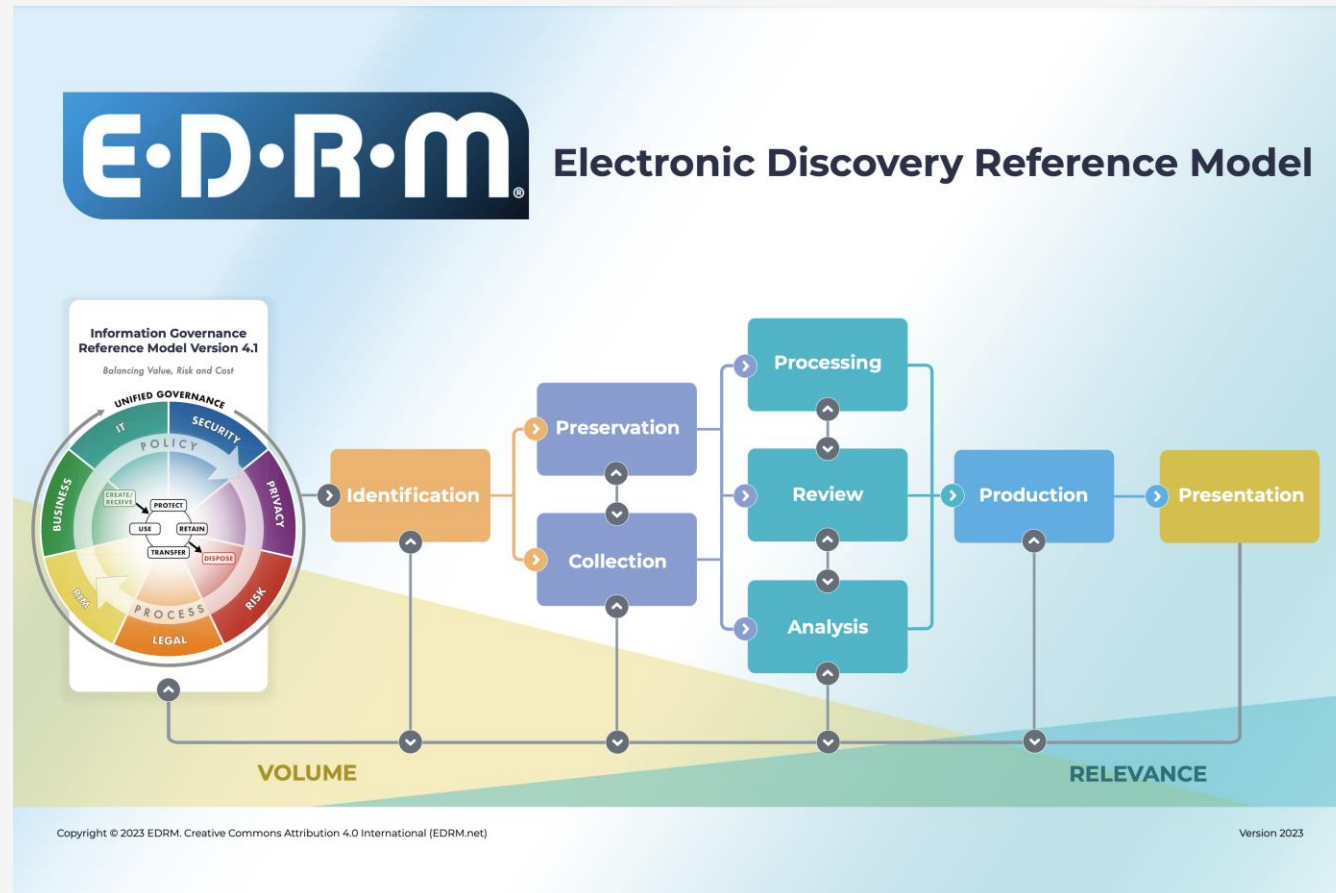
For Example: Chats, edits, reactions, AI prompts, and system logs, many times carry more weight than the finalized files.
